SUMMARY OF SECTION ACTIVITIES DURING 2004 – 2005 **(April 30, 2004 to April 15, 2005)**

Board of Directors:

- Nine Board meetings held.
- Active participation by Board members in all Section activities.
- AWRA National Board member attended several meetings.

Scholarship Program:

- Awarded three Richard Herbert Memorial Scholarships totaling \$6,000 (2 @ \$2,000 and 2 @ \$1,000) to two PhD students, one Masters student and one undergraduate student. The scholarship recipients attend Colorado School of Mines, Colorado State University and the University of Colorado.
- Since 1991, the Colorado Section has awarded 36 scholarships totaling over \$51,500.

Programs:

- Held ten monthly programs including:
 - Salt Cedar / Tamarisk Eradication Field Trip in Pueblo, CO
 - Nine luncheon programs at Denver Water on a wide variety of water resource topics
- Planned and coordinated 1-day symposium, *Colorado Water Supply Status and Sustainability*, co-sponsored by the Colorado Foundation for Water Education.

Newsletter and Website:

- Published and distributed one newsletter to membership regarding Section activities and other relevant water resource-related information.
- Maintained informative website for distribution of information to membership
