SUMMARY OF SECTION ACTIVITIES DURING 2006 – 2007

(April 30, 2006 to April 13, 2007)

Board of Directors:

- Twelve Board meetings held.
- Active participation by Board members in all Section activities.
- AWRA National Board member attended several meetings.
- Several members attended the AWRA National Conference in Baltimore, Maryland
- Colorado State Section received Honorable Mention for the State Section of the Year Award

Scholarship Program:

The AWRA-Colorado Section scholarships are given in memory of Rich Herbert, a former member of the Colorado Section and the National AWRA board of directors. Rich had a great interest in water-resources education and was instrumental in establishing the Colorado Section scholarship fund.

- Awarded five Richard Herbert Memorial Scholarships totaling \$8,000 to three PhD students, one Masters student and one undergraduate student. This year, all of the scholarship recipients attend Colorado State University
- With these recipients, the Colorado Section of AWRA has awarded 47 scholarships since 1991 totaling over \$66,000.
- The distribution of these 47 scholarships by degree is 23 to PhD students, 21 to MS/MA students, and 3 to BS students.
- By college, the distribution of these 47 scholarships is 26 to Colorado State University, 10 to the University of Colorado, 9 to Colorado School of Mines, and 2 to the University of Denver.
- The scholarship fund is supported by member donations and by the proceeds of the Section's Annual Symposium.

Programs:

- Held eleven monthly programs including:
 - Tour of Aurora's Xeriscape Garden
 - Ten luncheon programs at Denver Water on a wide variety of water resource topics
- Planned and coordinated 1-day symposium, *Colorado Water Supply Cooperation before Crisis*

Newsletter and Website:

- Published and distributed electronic newsletters to membership regarding Section activities and other relevant water resource-related information.
- Maintained informative website for distribution of information to membership
